June 27, 2022

- Meeting The regular meeting of the Chateaugay Town Board was called to order at 6:30 P.M. on June 27, 2022 at the Chateaugay Town Hall by Supervisor Donald Bilow.
- Members Present Supervisor Donald Bilow, Councilman William Trombly, Councilman Jim Harrigan, Councilman Scott Cowan, Councilman Kirby Selkirk, Town Clerk Phyllis LeMay and Highway Superintendent Roger LaBombard.
- Visitors JoEllen Saumier and Village of Chateaugay Mayor Matthew Clarke.
- Minutes A motion was made by Kirby Selkirk and seconded by Scott Cowan to adopt the minutes from the June 13, 2022 board meeting. All in favor, motion carried.
- Fire Department JoEllen Saumier came before the Board to explore possibilities of the Town, Village and fire department using shared services to upgrade the upper section of the parking lot at the fire station.
- 2022 Projects Supervisor Donald Bilow discussed the following:

Bowling Alley – The grant was approved in the amount of \$125,000 for the bowling alley improvement project.

Pickleball Fence – The pickleball fence bid from C&E has been approved by the CRC.
- HUD Resolution #27 A motion was made by Bill Trombly and seconded by Scott Cowan to approve resolution #27 stating Town of Chateaugay will only assist clients who have equity available based on their fair market value and any applicable liens. All in favor, motion carried.
- Rec Park Supervisor Bilow reported that the rec park opened today.
- Assessor Training Supervisor Donald Bilow reported that there will be assessor training on July 17 through July 22, the Town of Chateaugay will split the cost of the training with the Town of Bellmont for Amy Hewitt.
- Auction The Franklin County auction will be held on August 3, 2022 at the Franklin County courthouse. Supervisor inquired about checking on some property that the town may be interested in.
- Norbut Norbut Solar Farms has requested the balance in their account be returned to them. A motion was made by Kirby Selkirk and seconded by Jim Harrigan to return Norbut's money, all in favor, motion carried.

Reports Roger LaBombard reported the following:

That there have been several washouts with all the rain.

New Western Star truck repair is done.

One mile of grinding on the Cassidy Road will start on 6/28.

A motion was made by Bill Trombly and seconded by Kirby Selkirk to approve highway superintendent Roger LaBombard attending the Cornell Roads conference for September 20 through September 23.
