- Meeting** The regular meeting of the Chateaugay Town Board was called to order at 6:30 P.M. on January 24, 2022 at the Chateaugay Town Hall by Supervisor Donald Bilow. All town officials and guests were required to sanitize their hands and wear a mask.

- Visitors** Jim Harrigan Jr.
- Minutes** A motion was made by William Trombly and seconded by Kirby Selkirk to adopt the corrected minutes of the January 10, 2022 board meeting. Corrections are Doug Nemier's title is watchman and Lori Rowe court secretary pay is \$100 a month. All in favor, motion carried.
- Solar** Supervisor Donald Bilow reported that the Town has received the signed HCA and decommissioning documents from Norbut.

- Capital Projects** A. Rec Park – replacing bath house –John requested a draft contract from DASNY.


