Minutes September 23, 2024

Meeting	The regular meeting of the Chateaugay Town Board on 09/23/2024 was called to order by Supervisor Donald Bilow at 6:30 P.M.

Minutes	A motion was made by Kirby Selkirk and seconded by Bill Trombly to adopt the minutes of the September 9, 2024 board meeting. All in favor, motion carried.
Capital Projects	Bowling Alley - Supervisor Bilow reported that he reached out to John Carr from Blue Mountain Engineering to get an update as to when the bids for the bowling alley project would go out. Councilman Jim Harrigan suggested maybe finding a new engineer.
Solar	There is nothing new to report.

Battery Storage	Josh Leriscy from Blue Wave Energy

Ambulance Foothills	Supervisor Donald Bilow reported that he had an excellent report regarding Foothill ambulance service.
Budget	Supervisor Bilow reported that we will have a budget review at 6:00 pm on October 21st.
Charging Stations	Supervisor Bilow and Board discussed where to put new charging stations. We will consider the town hall parking lot.

Reports Highway Superintendent Roger LaBombard reported the following:

- The men have done a lot of shimming
- Still mowing roadsides, they are on the Chasm Road
- Roger presented a quote for a SANY loader in amount of \$169,500.
The price to trade loaders would be \$88,000.

Supervisor Bilow – Reported that he is having a difficult time keeping track of the renewable energy projects and that ORES is very frustrating to work with. The bookkeeping for Lori is a nightmare as some bills are 6 to 8 months overdue.
