Minutes September 9, 2024

- Public Hearing There was a legal notice in the Malone Telegram that a public hearing would be held on this night to discuss Local Law #3 of 2024. A motion was made by Kirby Selkirk and seconded by Scott Cowan to open the public hearing at 6:20 PM. All in favor, motion carried. There were no interested persons that attended. A motion was made by Kirby Selkirk and seconded by Scott Cowan to close the public hearing at 6:30 PM. All in favor, motion carried.
- Meeting The regular meeting of the Chateaugay Town Board on 09/9/2024 was called to order by Supervisor Donald Bilow at 6:30 P.M.
- Members Present Supervisor Donald Bilow, Councilman William Trombly, Councilman Scott Cowan, Councilman Kirby Selkirk, Town Clerk Phyllis LeMay, Highway Superintendent Roger LaBombard and Councilman Jim Harrigan was absent.

- Minutes A motion was made by Bill Trombly and seconded by Scott Cowan to adopt the minutes of the August 19, 2024 board meeting, with one change. All in favor, motion carried.
- Capital Projects Bowling Alley - Supervisor Bilow reported that he reached out to John Carr from Blue Mountain Engineering to get an update as to when the bids for the bowling alley project would go out.
- Wind There is nothing new to report.
- Solar There is nothing new to report.
- Teamster's Contract Supervisor Bilow and Board have tabled the teamster's contract. We need the full contract.
- Local Law #3 of 2024 Resolution # 35 A motion was made by Bill Trombly and seconded by Kirby Selkirk to approve the Tax Cap override, Local Law #3 of 2024. A roll call vote was taken with the following results: William Trombly – Aye, Scott Cowan – Aye, Jim Harrigan – Absent, Kirby Selkirk –Aye, and Supervisor Donald Bilow, Aye. Motion carried.
- Assessor The Town of Chateaugay completed a reappraisal on the 2023 assessment roll that makes the town eligible for aid in the amount of \$7,766.01.

- B&C Resolution #36 A motion was made by Bill Trombly and seconded by Scott Cowan to approve B & C Driveway Sealing's quote of \$5,509.00 to prepare, edge, clean, seal and patch and hot cracking the town hall parking lot, all in favor, motion carried.
- Tire Recycling Franklin County Soil and Water Conservation is having a drop off of tires on September 11 from 3 PM to 6 PM at the Chateaugay town highway garage located at 7354 State Route 374.
- Flail Mower Supervisor Bilow discussed a new flail mower, he will look into getting quotes.
- Concerts Supervisor Bilow reported that are three concerts coming up, Glengarry Bhoys on 9/14, Harvest & Rust on 10/5 and Beartracks on 10/19.
- Budget Supervisor Bilow asked if anyone had anything to add to the 2025 budget. Highway Superintendent Roger LaBombard said that paving prices have increased and also mentioned getting a loader and a dozer.
- Charging Stations Supervisor Bilow and Board discussed where to put new charging stations. We will consider the town hall parking lot.
- Auction Supervisor Bilow reported that the Franklin County Tax Foreclosure real estate auction will be held on September 17, 2024 at 10 AM, there is nothing that the Town is interested in.
- Battery Disconnect A motion was made by Bill Trombly and seconded by Scott Cowan to sign a NYMIR form for the battery disconnects on all heavy duty trucks, all in favor, motion carried.
- Reports Highway Superintendent Roger LaBombard reported the following:
- The salt and sand building is being repaired
  - Needs to get new parts for the mower
  - Been working on culverts
  - Roger presented a quote for a SANY loader in amount of \$169,500. We could get \$88,000 for the Town's John Deere loader.
- Bill Trombly – Bill asked Don about getting internet at the highway garage.
- Bills A motion was made by Kirby Selkirk and seconded by Scott Cowan to pay the bills. Motion carried, all in favor.

Adjournment A Motion was made by Kirby Selkirk and seconded by Scott Cowan to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried, all in favor.
