Minutes February 24, 2025

- Meeting The regular meeting of the Chateaugay Town Board on 02/24/2025 was called to order by Supervisor Donald Bilow at 6:30 P.M.
- Members Present Supervisor Donald Bilow, Councilman William Trombly, Councilman Scott Cowan, Councilman Kirby Selkirk, Highway Superintendent Roger LaBombard, Town Clerk Phyllis LeMay and Councilman Jim Harrigan was absent.
- Visitors Warren Salo and Thomas Haynes from DANC
- DANC Thomas Haynes and Warren Salo presented the information that is available on the DANC GIS website. Warren will come to the town to give a demonstration. They also presented a contract if the town desires to approve it.
- Minutes A motion was made by Kirby Selkirk and seconded by Scott Cowan to adopt the minutes of the February 10, 2025 Town Board meeting. All in favor, motion carried.
- Lease Town attorney is working on a lease for Mr. Legault. We will publish when the public hearing will be held.
- Capital Projects Supervisor Donald Bilow reported that he called John Carr and regarding the bowling alley project and he is waiting for a call back. A motion was made by Kirby Selkirk and seconded by Scott Cowan to have the town attorney write a letter to John Carr from Blue Mountain Engineering regarding the status of the bowling alley project, all in favor, motion carried.
- Time Cards A motion was made by Bill Trombly and seconded by Scott Cowan to approve the purchase of software for a time card tracker at the price of Resolution #18 \$180/\$324 per year. All in favor, motion carried.
- Solar Historical Money: Councilman Bill Trombly and Councilman Kirby Selkirk will ask about the status of the SHIPO funds.
- HCA meeting will be held on February 27, 2025 at 11 AM, William Trombly and Kirby Selkirk will represent the town.
- Prior Notice A motion was made by Kirby Selkirk and seconded by Scott Cowan to approve beginning the process to complete the Prior Notice Law, all in favor, motion carried.

- NYSDOC** A motion was made by Bill Trombly and seconded by Scott Cowan to approve Resolution #19 in support of New York State Department of Corrections employees.
- Resolution #19** A roll call vote was taken with the following results: William Trombly – Aye, Scott Cowan – Aye, Jim Harrigan – Absent, Kirby Selkirk – Present, and Supervisor Donald Bilow, Aye.
- Summer Camp** Application – Kim Raville is working with the NYS Department of Health on the application for the summer day camp program.
- Health Director – We will have to appoint a health director for the rec park program.
- Reports** Highway Superintendent Roger LaBombard – Roger reported the following:
