April 11, 2022

- Meeting** The regular meeting of the Chateaugay Town Board was called to order at 6:30 P.M. on April 11, 2022 at the Chateaugay Town Hall by Supervisor Donald Bilow.
- Members Present** Supervisor Donald Bilow, Councilman William Trombly, Councilman Jim Harrigan, Councilman Scott Cowan, Councilman Kirby Selkirk, and Highway Superintendent Roger LaBombard, Town Clerk Phyllis LeMay was absent.
- Visitors** Lori Rowe, Director of Finance filled in for Town Clerk Phyllis LeMay.
- Minutes** A motion was made by Kirby Selkirk and seconded by Jim Harrigan to adopt the minutes from the March 28, 2022 board meeting. All in favor, motion carried.
- 2022 Projects** Supervisor Donald Bilow discussed the following:
- Bath House – Supervisor Donald Bilow reported John Carr had a pre-bid inspection at the rec park on 4/4/2022, only one (1) contractor showed up so John will advertise again.
- Bowling Alley –Supervisor Donald Bilow reported that the application for the bowling alley has been submitted to DASNY.
- Automated Bromine – John Carr sent a report on automated bromine controllers. Hayward CAT4000 Series Controller unit cost approximately \$4000 per unit plus sensors, \$320 each. The Rola-Chem system sell for approximately \$2000 per unit plus sensors at \$200 each.
- Pickleball Court – Councilman Kirby Selkirk reported that he sent the dimensions to C & E Fencing for the fence and quote and is waiting to hear back on a price.
- Lead Agency** Supervisor Donald Bilow reported that the Brookside Solar project will need a lead agency. Either the Town of Chateaugay or the Town of Burke will have to be lead agency. After discussing it was decided that either town would be fine to be the lead agency for the project.

Theater Supervisor Donald Bilow reported that the movies have had very low attendance. The comedy show will be on April 30<sup>th</sup> and asked the Board if they would be interested in have a Scottish band perform at the theater. Everyone was interested and will have theater director get additional information.

HUD Friends of the North Country asked the Board to approve project number Chat 20-04 expenditure of \$44,800.

Resolution #20 A motion was made by Kirby Selkirk and seconded by Scott Cowan to pass Resolution #20 to authorize the capital expenditure. All in favor, motion carried.

Martin Road Supervisor Donald Bilow reported that town attorney Brian Stewart said if the Town has not maintained the Martin Road for more than 10 years then the road has lost its status as a town road by use. The town has no responsibility.

Reports Roger LaBombard reported the following:

1. He should have bids this week on supplies for repairs for jobs that he would like to be done this summer.
2. Roger reported that the highway employees started working four ten-hour days. They started rough grading, picking up brush and trees and will start sweeping the roads on 4/18/2022.
3. Roger asked Don if he knew of any USDA grants for equipment for municipalities.

Donald Bilow – Don told the board that Barb LaBare had invited him and the town board to her 85<sup>th</sup> birthday party on 4/13/2022.
