- Meeting The regular meeting of the Chateaugay Town Board on 05/20/2024 was called to order by Supervisor Donald Bilow at 6:30 P.M.
- Members Present Supervisor Donald Bilow, Councilman Scott Cowan, Councilman Kirby Selkirk, Town Clerk Phyllis LeMay and Highway Superintendent Roger LaBombard. Councilman William Trombly and Councilman Jim Harrigan was absent.

- Minutes A motion was made by Kirby Selkirk and seconded by Scott Cowan to adopt the minutes of the May 6, 2024, board meeting. All in favor, motion carried.
