Minutes July 22, 2024

- Meeting The regular meeting of the Chateaugay Town Board on 07/22/2024 was called to order by Supervisor Donald Bilow at 6:30 P.M.
- Members Present Supervisor Donald Bilow, Councilman William Trombly, Councilman Scott Cowan, Councilman Kirby Selkirk, Councilman Jim Harrigan, Town Clerk Phyllis LeMay and Highway Superintendent Roger LaBombard was absent.
- Visitors David Legault, Suzanne Stevens and John Hill
- J. Hill John Hill came before the board to discuss the new wind towers that are going up and expressed his concerns with the height, distance and low frequency noise of the towers.
- S. Stevens Sue Stevens came before the board to thank the town support for allowing her to host the Vet Fest at the rec park and for the use of the town hall theater.
- Minutes A motion was made by Kirby Selkirk and seconded by Scott Cowan to adopt the minutes of the June 24, 2024, board meeting. All in favor, motion carried.
- Capital Projects Bowling Alley - Supervisor Bilow reported that he reached out to John Carr from Blue Mountain Engineering to get an update as to when the bids for the bowling alley project would go out.
- Pool Controllers – Supervisor Bilow said the pool controllers have not arrived yet.
- Terra Gen A motion was made by Scott Cowan and seconded by Jim Harrigan to approve Attorney Eric Gustafson from Pease & Gustafson for the Terra-Gen wind project and approve Barton and Loguidice as engineering consultants.
- Resolution #32 A roll call vote was taken with the following results: William Trombly – Abstain, Scott Cowan – Aye, Jim Harrigan – Aye, Kirby Selkirk – No, and Supervisor Donald Bilow, Aye. Motion carried.
- Fuel Agreement Supervisor Bilow presented the Fuel Agreement with Chateaugay Central School.
- Resolution #33 A motion was made by Kirby Selkirk and seconded by Scott Cowan to approve the fuel agreement, all in favor, motion carried.
- Rec Park Supervisor Donald Bilow reported that the rec park has been running smoothly. Maggie Farrell and Kim Raville are doing a great job.

Maggie would like to get security camera's for the rec park.

Negotiations Supervisor Donald Bilow reported that they are working on the Teamster's contract with the highway employees and highway committee.

Broadband Supervisor sent a letter of support for the Franklin County broadband application.

Lease Supervisor Donald Bilow requested attorney Matt McArdle to draw up a lease for property on the Chasm Road.

Resolution #34 A motion was made by Bill Trombly and seconded by Scott Cowan to approve the attorney to draw up a lease agreement, all in favor, motion carried.

Food Pantry Marie Doria has resigned her duties from the food pantry and Amanda Sweet and Connie Merrill will assume the operation of the pantry.

CRC Supervisor Donald Bilow reported that the CRC will be having a breakfast on Sunday July 28th from 8 AM to noon at the rec park.

Reports Kirby Selkirk – Kiosk is almost completed on the Chasm Road.


Donald Bilow – Supervisor presented a proposal from Clinton County Health Department for a Breastfeeding, Chestfeeding, and Lactation Friendly New York grant. A motion was made by Kirby Selkirk and seconded by Scott Cowan to endorse the proposal for a Breastfeeding, Chestfeeding, and Lactation Friendly New York.

Bills A motion was made by Kirby Selkirk and seconded by Scott Cowan to pay the bills. Motion carried, all in favor.
