May 23, 2022

- Meeting** The regular meeting of the Chateaugay Town Board was called to order at 6:30 P.M. on May 23, 2022 at the Chateaugay Town Hall by Supervisor Donald Bilow.
- Members Present** Supervisor Donald Bilow, Councilman William Trombly, Councilman Jim Harrigan, Councilman Scott Cowan, Councilman Kirby Selkirk, Town Clerk Phyllis LeMay and Highway Superintendent Roger LaBombard.
- Visitors** Susan Picard from Friends of the North Country and Marie Doria from the Chateaugay Food Pantry.
- Minutes** A motion was made by Kirby Selkirk and seconded by Scott Cowan to adopt the minutes from the May 9, 2022 board meeting. All in favor, motion carried.
- Theater** Supervisor Donald Bilow reported that the Busco Bandits will be here on July 15<sup>th</sup>. A motion was made by Bill Trombly and seconded by Scott Cowan to waive the cover charge, all in favor, motion carried. Heather also reported that she is working on a grant to replace the sign in front of the town hall.
- 2022 Projects** Supervisor Donald Bilow discussed the following:
- Bowling Alley – John Carr from Blue Mountain Engineering has come to the bowling alley to make more measurements and progress has been made.
- Theater UV – Waiting on an update on the theater UV system.
- Brookside** Road Use Agreement – A motion was made by Kirby Selkirk and seconded by Scott Cowan to send the AES Road Use Agreement to the (renewable energy consultants), The West Firm and Barton & Loguidice for review.
- Multi Jurisdiction Hazzard** A motion was made by Kirby Selkirk and seconded by Scott Cowan to approve with corrections the Franklin County Multi Jurisdiction Hazzard plan. Resolution #25 All in favor, motion carried.
- HUD** Sue Picard from Friends of the North Country asked the Board to approve project number CHAT-20-05 expenditure of \$10,850.00.
- Resolution #26 A motion was made by Bill Trombly and seconded by Kirby Selkirk to pass Resolution #26 to authorize the capital expenditure. All in favor, motion carried.

Donald Bilow – Eric Will called and said that the Host Community Agreement that AES paid to the Town of Chateaugay was overpaid by \$100,000.


Don also reported that there is \$64 dollars in the sunshine fund.
