- Meeting** The regular meeting of the Chateaugay Town Board was called to order at 6:30 P.M. on February 28, 2022 at the Chateaugay Town Hall by Supervisor Donald Bilow.
- Members Present** Supervisor Donald Bilow, Councilman William Trombly, Councilman Jim Harrigan Jr., Councilman Kirby Selkirk, Town Clerk Phyllis LeMay, Highway Superintendent Roger LaBombard, and Councilman Scott Cowan was absent.
- Visitors** John Carr from Blue Mountain Engineering, Chateaugay Central School students Nathan Harrigan and Emily Dibble.
- Minutes** A motion was made by William Trombly and seconded by Kirby Selkirk to adopt the minutes from the February 14, 2022 board meeting. All in favor, motion carried.
- 2022 Projects** Supervisor Donald Bilow discussed the following:
- Bath House and Concession – John reviewed the plans for the bath house replacement with the Board.
- Bowling Alley – John said the report for upgrading the bowling alley is almost complete.
- UV Theater – Equipment is not available, we will keep working on getting the equipment.
- Solar**
- A. Solar permit application will be discussed at the next board meeting.
 - B. Brookside Solar Application – application is upstairs in the conference room. A motion was made by Kirby Selkirk and seconded by Jim Harrigan to approve Barton and Loguidice and The West Firm as consultants for the Brookside solar project. All in favor, motion carried.
 - C. Martin Road – Is on the state road inventory.
- Concession** A motion was made by William Trombly and seconded by Jim Harrigan to approve the sink and refrigerator purchase for the concession stand at the rec park. All in favor, motion carried.

Office Space Supervisor Donald Bilow discussed with the Board that a man called to see if there was any office space available in the town.

Stimulus Funds Supervisor Donald Bilow reported that the stimulus funds report is due April 30th.

Workers Compensation Supervisor Donald Bilow reported that there were no claims for the second year in a row at the highway department.

Reports Roger LaBombard reported the following:

- Roger reported to the Board that since there was only one (1) bid for a new plow truck that he has decided not to accept the bid. Bill Trombly made a motion to reject all bids for the new plow truck and was seconded by Jim Harrigan, all in favor, motion carried.
- One of the trucks slid off the side of the road and it will be between \$1500 - \$2000 for the Lauzon tow truck to get it back on the road.
- He is working with Water & Soil to see about some grants, we will need to replace culverts on three (3) roads.


Bill Trombly – Bill discussed with the Board that the village would like the Town to complete three (3) water districts outside of the village limits. We will need information.

Kirby Selkirk – Kirby discussed with the Board the CRC newsletter. He also discussed how the new assessment would affect the taxes.

Bills A motion was made by Kirby Selkirk and seconded by Jim Harrigan to pay the bills. All in favor, motion carried.
