### Minutes June 24, 2024

- Meeting** The regular meeting of the Chateaugay Town Board on 06/24/2024 was called to order by Supervisor Donald Bilow at 6:30 P.M.
- Members Present** Supervisor Donald Bilow, Councilman William Trombly, Councilman Scott Cowan, Councilman Kirby Selkirk, Town Clerk Phyllis LeMay and Highway Superintendent Roger LaBombard. Councilman Jim Harrigan was absent.
- Visitors** David Legault
- Minutes** A motion was made by Kirby Selkirk and seconded by Bill Trombly to adopt the minutes of the June 10, 2024, board meeting. All in favor, motion carried.
- Capital Projects** Bowling Alley - Supervisor Bilow reported that he reached out to John Carr from Blue Mountain Engineering to get an update as to when the bids for the bowling alley project would go out.
- Jody Warriner reported on the repairs and maintenance of the bowling alley pinsetters.
- Pool Controllers – Supervisor Bilow presented a voucher for Spaulding Pool & Spa for pool controllers, voucher was signed for partial payment so the pool chemical controllers could be ordered.
- Chasm Rd** David Legault reached out to the town board regarding 5 acres of town property on the Chasm Road that he would like to lease, rent or purchase. Supervisor Bilow will reach out to town attorney Matt McArdle.
- Laptop** A motion was made by Kirby Selkirk and seconded by Scott Cowan to approve the purchase of a refurbished laptop for the theater in the amount of \$682.50, all in favor, motion carried.
- Resolution #31**
- Contract** Supervisor Bilow reported that he spoke to Micky Smith, we have the requests from the highway employees and negotiations will begin on the highway department teamster's contract. Brian Stewart has agreed to negotiate the contract.
- Trail System** Supervisor presented comments from Protect the Adirondacks regarding the Franklin County recreational trail system.
- Rec Park** Supervisor Donald Bilow reported that there have been two (2) cancellations for the rec pack. We will keep a list of cancellations for future references.

Reports Roger LaBombard reported the following:

- That the building materials are here for the salt & sand building. The town will remove the sand from the building and it will go to the Town of Burke and the Town of Burke will replace the sand once the building is repaired.
- 1.7 miles of paving has been completed on the Seymour Road.
- The Cassidy Road needs new guard rails where the new culvert was installed.
- The machinery to be sold will be advertised on July 10, 2024.

Kirby Selkirk – The historical society is building a kiosk on the Chasm Road site.
